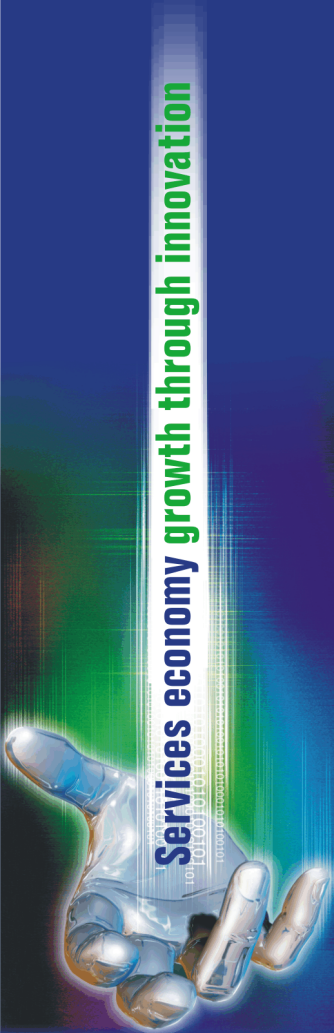


## Professor Archie Johnston - Director

Archie Johnston is a Fellow of Australian Academy of Technological Sciences and Engineering (ATSE), Engineers Australia, and, The Institution of Civil Engineers (London). He is Dean of Engineering and Information Technologies at The University of Sydney. He was previously in a similar role at the University of Technology Sydney. He is National Chair of the Centre for Leadership and Management (Engineers Australia), Deputy Chair of the Education Forum of ATSE, Advisor to the Reliance Group, Mumbai India, Advisory Professor to Shanghai Jiao Tong University, and, Advisor to the Associated Chambers of Commerce and Industry of India, India. He is a Graduate of the Australian Institute of Company Directors, a Director of the Warren Centre for Advanced Engineering, the Smart Services CRC and the CRC for Advanced Composite Structures. Every year from 2004 to 2009 he has been cited as one of the most Influential 100 Engineers in Australia. He was Chair of the Judging Panel for the 2009 Australian Construction Achievement Awards and is serving on the Judging Panel of 2010 Prime Minister's Science Prizes. He was the Sir John Holland 2007 Civil Engineer of the Year and 2007 Entrepreneurial Educator of the Year of the Business and Higher Education Roundtable. He is a former President of the Australian Council of Engineering Deans.
